ASTER Software Installation of the Ithéa protection key

Role of the key

The Ithéa key is a device used to protect the software against copies. Without a key, the software cannot transfer programs to the machine. The key must be connected to a USB port of the PC and requires the installation of a driver.



Illustration 1: **The driver and the key are correctly installed**. The 'Test' indicator does not appear in the window strip. The 'Ithea' icon appears in the taskbar (systray area)



Illustration 2: **The driver and/or the key are not installed.** The 'Test' indicator is displayed, an error message appears when the application is launched.

Installation

1) Run the SETUP.EXE program This program can be found on the CD supplied with the software, or downloaded from the Internet.

2) connect the key to the USB port of the PC.

Uninstallation

1) Close the program if it is running
